Pick up your guitar and stand it upright facing you as shown here. The magnified view above shows you the notes (see below) assigned to each string, from left to right, starting at string #6, down to string #1. You will notice the thickness of the strings decreases as you look at them from left to right.

The letters you see above each string are called Notes. There is a different note for each string. Starting from the left the notes are E, A, D, G, B, E. A good phrase to help you remember the note progression would be "Elvis Ate Dynamite, Good Bye Elvis".
